UMCOR Cleaning Kits (formerly Flood Buckets)

The Youth will be putting together Cleaning Kits (Flood Buckets) on Wednesday, October 27 to be delivered to UMCOR to help with flood recovery. We need your help! Our goal is a minimum of 36 buckets. Please bring any of the following items to the church by October 20, or make a donation toward this mission effort. Each bucket is valued at \$75.00.

Items included in Cleaning Kits are one each of: 5 gallon round bucket with lid, 32–64 oz. bottle liquid laundry detergent, 16–40 oz. bottle liquid concentrate household cleaner, 16–34 oz. bottle liquid dish soap, 4–8 oz. pump spray air freshener, 6–14 oz. pump spray insect repellent, scrub brush, 18 reusable cleaning wipes, 5 scouring pads, 36–50 clothespins, 50–100 ft. clothesline, 24 roll of heavy-duty trash bags (33–45 gallon sizes), 5 N95 particulate respirator dust masks (1–3 mm thickness), 2 pairs kitchen gloves, 1 pair work gloves.
