Mother's Morning Out Ministry

2020-2021 Parent Handbook

We welcome you and your child to the Mother's Morning Out (MMO) program of First United Methodist Church Bainbridge, Georgia. We provide a Christian atmosphere in which your 12 month to 24 month old child can learn to work and play with other children his/her own age. The curriculum includes music, art, sensory play, story-time, and other developmentally appropriate activities. The activities we plan encourage development while allowing each child to learn at his/her own pace. Parent involvement is very important to us. If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to share them with us.

Enrollment:

Mother's Morning Out:

-Ages 12 months to 24 months old (The child must turn 12 months old before September 1st) -Meets Mondays and Wednesdays -Hours of operation 9:00AM- 12:00PM

You may schedule a "meet and greet" with the director of MMO and teachers on Wednesdays.

We follow the Decatur County public school calendar, and our classes will be closed according to their holiday schedule.

Program Starts: Wednesday, September 9, 2020 Last Day: TBA *To enroll: Please submit the attached registration form, registration fee, 1st month's tuition, and schedule an orientation with the director.

Tuition and Fees:

An initial registration fee of \$50 is due at the time of enrollment. This fee covers special activities, holiday crafts, extra snacks, and some cleaning supplies.

Tuition for the 2020-2021 school year is a monthly fee of \$150.00 per child. There is a 10% discount available for families enrolling more than 1 child.

We do not refund tuition for absences, holidays, or any event that would require your child to leave the MMO program. Tuition is to be paid no later than the 2nd day of classes each month. **There is a \$20 late fee for not paying tuition on time.** Make checks payable to First United Methodist Church, and include your child's name and MMO Tuition in the "memo" section of the check.

Supplies: You will receive a supply list of common items we use in the classroom. Please send these supplies with your child during the first week of classes.

What to Bring:

- -Diaper Bag (diapers, wipes, etc)
- -Change of clothes (all clearly labeled)
- -Snacks for your child
- -Sippie Cup for your child (filled with liquid of your choosing)
- -Weather appropriate attire, bug spray, sunscreen
- -Label all items -Please do not bring toys from home

Please send your child in play clothes!! We love to create learning experiences with your child that often involve getting messy! Your children will be learning through paint, outside play, and other sensory materials that may get on your child's clothes.

Policies and Procedures:

Hours of Operation: 9:00AM- 12:00PM (early drop off is available, no earlier than 8:30AM)

<u>Drop Off</u>: Please park in the church parking lot located on Florida Street across from the FUMC Sharpe Building. Walk/Carry your child across Florida Street into the Sharpe Building.

<u>Pick Up</u>: Parents are currently not allowed in the classrooms, so children will be escorted to their parents in the Sharp Building lobby for pick up by 12:00рм.

Security/Safety Procedures:

- -The front entrance to the Sharpe Building will be locked at 9:15 AM every morning. If you are planning to arrive late please inform the MMO director so that the door can be opened. Children will not be released to anyone other than the parent/guardian or persons listed on the registration form. Photo identification might be requested for verification.
- -Church entrances are closely monitored by cameras and front office staff.
- -FUMC requires that the MMO program follows the United Methodist Church's "Safe Sanctuaries" policy which includes having at least 2 adults in each classroom, observing

appropriate adult-child ratios, and completing background checks on all adults working with children.

- -You will be contacted directly by MMO director about any situations that concern your child's safety.
- -Failure to pick-up your child by 12:15 will result in the MMO staff contacting persons identified on your registration form under "emergency contacts". If contacts on the emergency contact sheet are not reachable the Decatur County Sherriff's Department will be contacted to do a welfare check at your home.

Snacks:

Children enrolled in Mother's Morning Out (12 months-24 months) should bring their own snack and sippy cup. We are PEANUT FREE facility so do not bring any snacks with peanuts or peanut butter.

BIRTHDAY SNACKS- We LOVE to celebrate birthdays at MMO. You may bring cupcakes, cookies, etc. for snack time on the day of your child's birthday. Please consult with the Director about allergy concerns before bringing ANY special snack.

Vaccination Policy:

Please be advised that we do not require proof of vaccinations for children to be enrolled in the MMO program. Therefore, your child may be enrolled in a class with other children who have not been vaccinated. We at MMO respectfully allow each of the families in our program to make the best choices for their children based on this information.

Sickness Policy:

Please do not send your child to MMO if he or she has: nausea or vomited within 24 hours, fever within 24 hours, runny nose with green/yellow discharge, diarrhea within 24 hours, conjunctivitis, the flu, or any other communicable illness.

General rules for returning to school:

- 1) Child must be on antibiotic therapy for 24 hours before returning and/or
- 2) Fever free for 24 hours-WITHOUT fever reducing medication and/or
- 3) Symptoms have subsided

If your child becomes ill at MMO we will contact you to pick up the child. Please notify the director if your child is diagnosed with any contagious disease or illness. We will notify other parents of the possibility of exposure to their child.

Head Lice-

As with our sickness policy, we have a no attendance policy regarding head lice at MMO. If we detect head lice in our classrooms, all children will be checked and parents will be notified. Any child with live lice and/or eggs (nits) will be sent home until treatment is administered and he/she must be completely lice free before they are permitted to return to school.

If your child has ANY allergies we must be informed-

Please let us know if your child is taking any medication and inform us of the possible side effects. However, we are not allowed to administer medications other than basic first aid for bumps, bruises, and scratches.

If your child is injured at MMO we will inform you the day the accident occurs.

Discipline:

Appropriate socialization skill building is a goal of the Mother's Morning Out Program.

Skills such as sharing, taking turns, and cooperating with teacher and other students is important for their educational future. We believe in positive discipline by reinforcing appropriate behaviors through praise and rewards and correcting inappropriate behavior through redirection, and providing individual attention to help a child with a particular situation.

Many children go through stages of biting and hitting. If a pattern occurs, a conference will be arranged to discuss appropriate disciplinary action.

Potty-Training:

Please inform your child's teacher(s) if you are in the process of potty-training. We will do our best to reinforce your method of training.

Separation Anxiety:

Separation anxiety is a common developmental trait that causes concern for many parents. The staff at MMO is trained to handle separation anxiety through redirection, positive reinforcement, and other behavior modification techniques. We ask parents not to linger in your child's classroom for too long in effort to limit disruptions in classroom management. We encourage you to discuss any concerns regarding separation anxiety with the director and teachers.

Developmental Concerns:

Please address any developmental concerns with your child's teacher(s). We will do our best to address these concerns in the classroom. If your child is receiving SLP, PT, OT or early intervention services please inform the director so that we can make accommodations for your child if necessary.

Curriculum and Schedule:

Our curriculum includes age-appropriate activities to encourage: Language and Literacy, Cognitive Development, Social/Emotional Development, Physical Development (gross and fine motor) and Spiritual Development. It includes: child and teacher initiated activities, large and small group interaction, alternating periods of quiet and active play, daily out-door activities (weather permitting), music and movement, developmental and age appropriate spiritual concepts.

We put a strong emphasis on Christian based holidays and events with little importance focused on secular events/characters (Santa Claus/Easter Bunny). The MMO program participates in mission activities throughout the year striving to teach the concepts of giving and helping others. One mission program we participate in is the FUMC food bank that provides 30-40 families with food every week. All we ask of our families is to clean out their pantries occasionally!

Daily Schedules:

Each day includes developmentally appropriate activities to encourage pre-academic and developmental skills based around an academic theme while providing time for socialization during snack time and outdoor free play. A strong emphasis is also put on Christian development through chapel time.

Daily Schedule: EXAMPLE 8:30 AM-9:00 AM: Drop-off

9:00 AM -9:15 AM: Station play/sensory exploration stations/social interaction

9:15 AM -9:30 AM: Circle Time (Potty Time/Diapering)

9:30 AM -10:00 AM: Outdoor play (weather permitting) or indoor games

10:00 AM -10:30 AM: Music/Enrichment Programs

10:30 AM -10:50 AM: Snack Time

10:50 AM -11:10 AM: Story time (Potty Time/Diapering)

11:10 AM -12:00 AM: Art and Crafts

12:00 AM: Pick-up

(Schedule is subject to change depending on weather and special planned activities.)
